### 2017-2018 Scholarship Criteria & Application Form

The College of **Fine Arts Advisory Board** (FAAB) awards annual scholarships to Fine Art undergraduate majors who have **demonstrated excellence** in their chosen field.

The FAAB Scholarship is **\$2,000**, divided in equal payments in the fall and spring semesters.

#### Scholarship Criteria:

- Current, full-time declared undergraduate major in the College of Fine Arts
- Junior or Senior status for the 2017-2018 academic year
- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Completed FAAB Scholarship Application
- Faculty evaluation (form attached)
- Personal interview with the FAAB Scholarship Committee

*Recipients of the FAAB Scholarship must maintain full-time status, a 3.0 GPA, and remain in good standing within their department.*

#### Scholarship Procedures:

##### Application Due Date: **Friday, February 17, 2017 before 5:00 pm**

- Submit your Application to the **main administrative offices of your Fine Arts major department**. Here is a list of administrative offices for each department:
  - Art & Art History – ART 161
  - Dance – MCD 108
  - Film & Media Arts – ART 270
  - Music – DGH 204
  - Theatre – PAB 206

**NOTE:** The Confidential **Faculty Evaluation Form** must be submitted **by the faculty member** directly to the office of your major department by **February 21, 2017** in order for the application to be complete.

##### Scholarship Interviews: **March 2017**

The FAAB Scholarship Committee will be conducting interviews in March 2017. There will be no interviews conducted during Spring Break. All finalists will need to make themselves available for a **fifteen-minute interview** during the assigned time period. Finalists will be contacted by the Dean's Office to schedule an interview.
